

Rheinhart Scholarship Fund

Sponsored by the Lydia Bible Study Class

Mission: To provide a scholarship to a high school senior who is a member of First Baptist Church and a participating member or the Youth Department.

These Scholarships will be given in either May or December upon graduation.

Who can apply?

1. Any High School senior who plans to attend a two or four year college or Accredited trade school within 6 months of graduation.
2. The applicant must be a faithful and participating member of FBCFH at least 1 year, or under extenuating circumstances preventing membership, be a faithful and participating attendee of FBCFH for at least 1 year with recommendation from the Senior Pastor to the Scholarship Committee for consideration.
3. Must earn a High School or Home School diploma that meets State High School graduation requirements.
4. Must have worked in some capacity as a volunteer at FBCFH. (for example: VBS, Children Sunday School, Choir, Nursery, landscaping, library, special projects, etc.)

The Scholarship money must be applied towards books or tuition.

Completed papers must be turned in to Scholarship Committee or Church Office no later than the third Sunday in April or second Sunday in November.

What students need to do

1. Attach a list of volunteer work with the date and hours you worked. You may include all work done from Freshman to Senior years. Please include references from Supervisors in the areas of service.

2. Submit essay no more than 2 pages, double-spaced. Choose one topic:
 - A. Tell how you plan to follow God's will as you continue your education
 - B. As a Christian how will it be your responsibility to give back to your community?
3. Attach an **official** copy of High School transcript and **proof** of college/trade school admission.
4. Describe your salvation experience.
