What it's about: This book speaks clearly to lust, pornography, and masturbation. It is a phenomenal book with lots of practical wisdom.



DIAMONDS CONTENT FOR PARENTS

Overview

- Jr High ladies struggle with who they are and who they want to be. In this struggle, they often forget that they were made to shire brilliantly, that they are priceless, and they are to reflect the image of God.
- The purpose of "Diamonds" is to bring attention to the ways their shine is being diminished (influences of the world/sin/etc).
- They each will receive a diamond representing their worth. During each session they will paint over their diamond, revealing how their diamond's shine has diminished. They will conclude the evening by washing their diamonds, affirming God's intention for their life ... they are to shine bright and reflecting Him. Matt 5:16 Let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.

Session 1 - Worth

- Our struggle of worth is based on:
 - Other's opinions
 - The world's standard
 - Our own expectations
 - The comparison game

The truth:

- Our worth is based on the truth that we are children of God, intentionally created by Him. (Ps 139: 13-16)
- Ways to remember your worth:
 - Read your Bible
 - Pray
 - Know you are good enough



DIAMONDS CONTENT FOR PARENTS

Session 2 - Guys & Dating

- How you decide and who you decide to date is critical.
 - We tend to make decisions on *how* we date based on qualities that don't matter much (physical attributes). We tend to make our decisions about *who* we date emotionally.
- Who to date: Establish qualities that will really matter in a guy
 - 1 Tim 4:12 Guy
- What you should do:
 - Write down a list of qualities and keep it
 - Never settle, never compromise, and always keep to the standards God has laid on your heart.
 - You are too valuable to settle. You are too precious to compromise, and you are too loved to not have a guy that loves and follows God.
- How to date: Establish Boundaries
 - Verbally: What are you allowed to talk about? Don't talk about love or marriage until you have a diamond (LMD). Doing so unites you emotionally before he time is right. Wait until it counts.
 - Geographically: Where are you allowed to be with him?
 - Physically: What are your physical standards for purity?

Session 3 - Sexual Purity

- What the Bible says about sex:
 - God created it (Gen 2:24) therefore it is good
 - God warns us about sex outside of His plan (Eph 5:3-4, 1 Cor 6:18-19)
- Sex outside of His plan:
 - Has physical consequences (STD, pregnancy)
 - Has emotional consequences (hurt, rejection, gossip, reputation)
- Sex inside of His plan:
 - Gives you freedom from pain and guilt
 - Honors God
- Everything costs something. If you CHOOSE to have sex, you will have to
 pay the consequences. If you choose to wait until marriage, you too will
 have to pay-consequences of being different, possibly ridiculed, rejected. It
 will NOT be easy! Know the cost, weigh the cost, and decide if the future
