## Rheinhart Scholarship Fund Sponsored by the Lydia Class

Who can apply?

- 1. Any high school senior who has plans to attend a two or four year college within 6 months of his/her high school graduation.
- 2. The applicant must have been a faithful and participating member of First Baptist Church of Fountain Hills for at least 1 year.
- 3. Must earn a high school diploma or have completed the courses of a home school program to meet state high school graduation requirements.
- 4. Must have worked in some capacity as a volunteer at FHFBC, (for example), VBS, Children Sunday school leader, Choir, Landscaping, Church clean up, Nursery, Library work or special needs work.

The Scholarship money must be applied towards books or tuition at a two or four year college.

Completed papers are to be turned in to the Scholarship Committee (Lydia Class) by April 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.

What the students need to do?

- 1. Attach a list of volunteer work with the date and hours you worked. Students can include all work done from Freshman year to Senior year in high school. Please include references from the people who supervised your work.
- 2. Submit an essay, no more than 2 pages, double-spaced; choose one of the two choices.
- 1. Tell how you plan to follow God's will while you are in college.
- 2. As a Christian how will it be your responsibility to give back to your community?
- 3. Attach an <u>official</u> copy of your transcript and provide information about your college admission.
